Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS)

The MCBDD will follow Ohio Department of Education Policy (approved 1/15/2013) to implement Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) which is a broad range of systemic and individualized strategies for improving important social and learning skills in the school community while reducing problem behavior. PBIS will include preventive activities such as data-based decision making and on going staff training.

The MCBDD will implement strategies to prevent the need for the use of restraint and seclusion. Restraint or seclusion will not occur, except when there is immediate risk of harm to staff, students or others and will only occur to protect the safety of all children and adults in the school environment. The use of restraint and seclusion will be documented and reported according to the requirements by Ohio Department of Education and Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities.
