

Medina County Board of Developmental Disabilities Board Members

The Medina County Board of Developmental Disabilities is comprised of seven volunteer members who are appointed by the Medina County Commissioners or a Medina County Probate Judge. Board member terms are 4 years long and they receive no compensation for their service. Board members must be Medina County residents and have various professional backgrounds and include community leaders and family members of individuals with disabilities. Each year board members must attend at least four hours of training in the field of developmental disabilities.

Board Meetings

Meetings are typically held on the fourth Monday of each month at 5:30 pm at the MCBDD Achievement Center. Agency business, policy, budgets, and program planning are discussed during Board meetings. Staff and community members are always welcome and encouraged to attend.

WAYNE CARROLL - President
