Special Event Volunteers

Special Event Volunteers assist staff with single events, projects, or outings. These volunteers must be **at least 12 years old**.

Opportunities include: School Field Trips, Outings, Community Shred Day, Ice Cream Social, Agency Celebrations, Field Day, and other community events.

Scheduled Volunteers

Scheduled Volunteers assist staff, enrollees or students on a regularly scheduled basis determined by the volunteer and the Volunteer Coordinator. Scheduled volunteers must be **at least 18 years old**.

Opportunities include: Clerical Support, Classroom Helper, Work Center Support, Social and Recreational Activities, and Educational Programs.
