At this time we understand that Non-Medical Transportation (NMT) services are significantly impacted and threatened by both a lack of drivers and the significant rise in fuel prices. The MCBDD wants to help by offering support to our local DD agency service providers.

We are now offering Fuel Cost Support for Agency Providers.

The Medina County Board of Developmental Disabilities recognizes the significant impact current economic factors are having on maintaining the availability of services in the county. The MCBDD believes it is critical to continue to offer an array of supports to providers to ensure quality and necessary services are available to individuals with developmental disabilities.

Here's How It Works...

Under this program, agency providers who provide Non-Medical Transportation (NMT) services are eligible for consideration to receive payments to be used towards fuel costs.

PROGRAM SUMMARY

Reimbursement Amounts

To ensure NMT services continue to operate, MCBDD will reimburse the agency provider 25% of their monthly fuel expenses (excluding any taxes).

Provider Agency

A provider agency will need to sign and return an "Agreement for Provider Assistance" form to the MCBDD Director of Community Development prior to requesting fuel cost reimbursement through this program.

Provider agencies will be required on the appropriate form to attest to the fact that receipts or invoices submitted for reimbursement are for MCBDD ISP approved services.

Provider must provide the number of unduplicated individuals served for the corresponding month (each individual served should only be counted once per month),

Payments will be made directly to the provider agency.
