Intervention for Peace provides Homemaker Personal Care Services, Vocational Habilitation, Non-medical Transportation and Remote Supports. Waivers include I/O, Level 1, Self, and local funding. IFP serves individuals in Medina, Summit, Portage, Wayne and Cuyahoga Counties
