We are now offering a Homemaker Personal Care (HPC) and Non-Medical Transportation (NMT) Grant Funds Support Program for Independent Service Providers.

The Medina County Board of Developmental Disabilities recognizes that Independent Providers are significantly affected by the increased costs of supporting individuals in community settings. The MCBDD believes it is critical to continue to offer an array of supports to providers to ensure quality and necessary services are available to individuals with Other provider support programs continue to be offered. Under this program, independent service providers who provide Homemaker Personal Care (HPC) and Non-Medical Transportation (NMT) services are eligible for consideration to receive grant funds.

PROGRAM SUMMARY

Grant Fund Amounts

39 Hours or Less - Independent Providers who bill 39 hours or less for the month are eligible for a \$50 per month grant fund

40 Hours or More - Independent Providers who bill 40 hours or more for the month are eligible for a \$100 per month grant fund

MCBDD will determine the hours worked for each Independent Provider based on claims billed for the time period of July-Sept. 2022.

NOTE: It is important any outstanding billing claims for the time period of July through Sept. 2022 must be submitted by Nov. 9, 2022 to be considered for this program. No reports will be run after this date.

Independent Providers

Independent Providers will be required to complete and return a "Request for Independent Provider Support" form to the MCBDD Director of Community Development when requesting grant funds through this program.

Independent Providers must submit a current W9, if not previously submitted to MCBDD, to receive the grant funds.

A one time payment for the three month period (July-Sept. 2022) will be made directly to the Independent Provider.
