In this training, providers will...

- Understand how trauma impacts behavior in order to help in daily crisis moments
- Learn how to employ a person-centered approach that offers inclusive and sensitive strategies
- Learn how, why, and when to apply safety interventions and disengagement techniques to address risky behaviors

The MCBDD is offering two options to provider staff and Independent Providers:

- 1-day Verbal Intervention Training
- Full 2-day Non-violent Crisis Intervention Training and Certification, including safety interventions (hands-on)

Participants must attend the 2-day course to receive the full CPI certification.

This training will be free of charge to Medina County providers in 2024.
